H-Building

Inside Campus Police (H-132)

K-Building

KACC main entrance near K-113

S-Building

Downstairs— On wall next to S-140

What is an AED?

AED stands for Automated External Defibrillator.

It is a medical device that analyzes the heart's rhythm.

If necessary, it delivers an electrical shock, known as defibrillation, which helps the heart re-establish an effective rhythm.
