#### **Hours Required Toward Completion:**

Minimum of 60 semester credit hours or 90 quarter credit hours from ACC. Minimum of 48 quarter credit hours of core and specialization coursework completed at Capella University (at least 24 of those quarter credit hours must be taken from within the specialization courses). A maximum of 132 quarter credit hours (88 semester credit hours) may be transferred to Capella University.

A.A.S. Criminal Justice – Correctional Science students applying for any B.S. in Public Safety must complete 6 quarter credits of core, specialization, or acceptable General Education coursework to reach junior status at Capella University. Students must complete 9 acceptable quarter credits of General Education coursework, including at least 1.5 acceptable quarter credits of Mathematics/Natural Science coursework to fulfill Capella University's General Education requirement.

A.A.S. Criminal Justice – Law Enforcement students applying for any B.S. in Public Safety must complete 3.5 quarter credits of core, specialization, or acceptable General Education coursework to reach junior status at Capella University. Students must complete 13.5 acceptable quarter credits of General Education coursework, including at least 1.5 acceptable quarter credits of Mathematics/Natural Science coursework to fulfill Capella University's General Education requirement.
