



## Alvin Community College Automated External Defibrillator (AED) Locations

### **A-Building**

Downstairs— Back hallway near the entrance to Testing (around from Financial Aid Center)

Upstairs— Library/Learning Lab (across from Career Services)

### **B-Building**

Lobby of the Theatre

### **C-Building**

Downstairs— Lobby of Childcare

Upstairs— Paralegal hallway near the exit door of C-227

### **D-Building**

Upstairs— Inner hallway next to D-236

### **E-Building**

Dining area— Wall next to the second entrance to student activities

### **F-Building**

Main entrance next to F-109

### **G-Building**

South side of building near G-152

### **H-Building**

Inside Campus Police (H-132)

### **K-Building**

KACC main entrance near K-113

### **S-Building**

Downstairs— On wall next to S-140

### **What is an AED?**

AED stands for Automated External Defibrillator.

It is a medical device that analyzes the heart's rhythm.

If necessary, it delivers an electrical shock, known as defibrillation, which helps the heart re-establish an effective rhythm.
