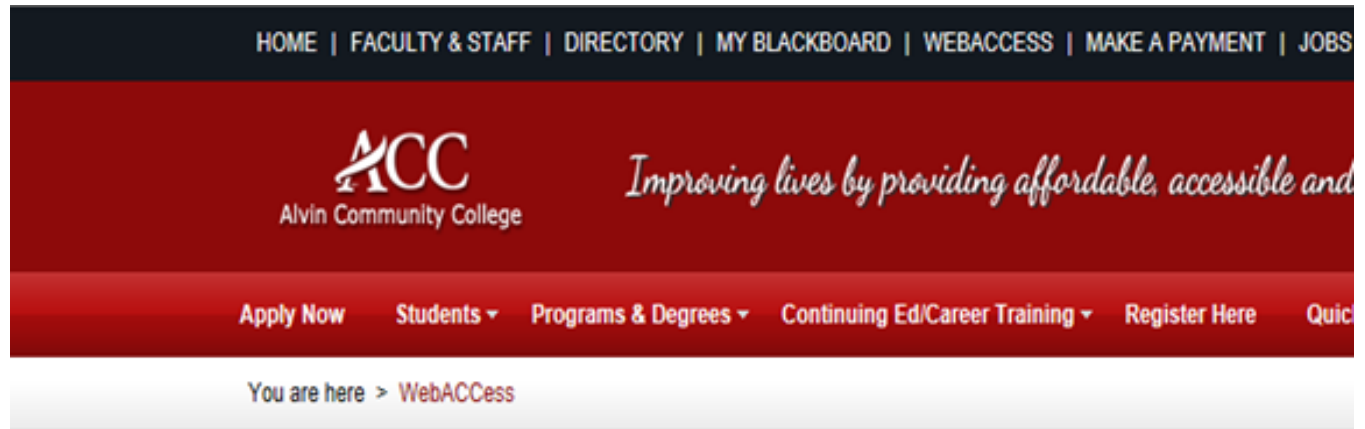

Applying

- Apply as an entering freshman
 - After completing one semester at the university, you will then be reclassified based on the hours of credit you have received and transferred in.
 - General Classification Chart (verify with your school of choice):
 - 0-29 Freshman
 - 30-59 Sophomore
 - 60+ Upperclassman
- If you are continuing to ACC, you are already an ACC student! You do not need to complete an admission application.
- Be sure to send your ACC and High School transcripts to the colleges as you apply.

Your ACC TRANSCRIPT

- You will need an unofficial and official copy of your transcript!
- Official copies should be sent as you apply and once you have been accepted.
- If you will be attending ACC, there is nothing additional for you to do!

Texas Success Initiative

- If you have taken English Dual Enrollment (Credit), and/or successfully passed TSI or met the SAT/ACT exemption, you do not need any additional testing in Reading or Writing.
- If you have taken Math 1314, and/or successfully passed TSI or met the SAT/ACT exemption, you do not need any additional testing in Math.
- Students planning to attend universities must still take the SAT and/or ACT.
- Students continuing with ACC or any other community college do not need to take the SAT and/or ACT (unless required for entry into a specific program).

Transfer Equivalency Guides

Once you have determined a school and major, review their course equivalency guide to see how your courses will transfer for that major.

Not all classes taken will transfer directly into your major. Some will transfer as electives.

Financial Aid: 4 Steps



STEP 1:

Complete the admission process. You must be fully admitted for your financial aid eligibility to be determined.

STEP 2:

Pin Number. Students must obtain a PIN to electronically sign the FAFSA. For dependent students, your parent must have a PIN also.

STEP 3:

Complete the FAFSA
The FREE Application for Federal Aid

STEP 4:

Submit all required documents. After receipt and review of FAFSA, students will receive an email requesting any additional documentation.

*****If prompted and eligible, use the data retrieval tool to avoid additional verification processes.*****

Reverse Transfer

- After completing 60hrs of course work (between ACC and your university of choice) you may become eligible for an Associate's degree through the Reverse Transfer Articulation program.
- To qualify students must:
 - *Complete 18 ACC credit hours
 - *Have a minimum 2.0 ACC GPA
 - *Complete the Texas Core Curriculum
 - *Complete the degree requirements for the ACC Associates of Art General Studies Degree.

Tips & Reminders

- ✓ Remember to send both your ACC and high school transcript as you apply and once you have selected your school of choice.
- ✓ Be sure to schedule a meeting with an advisor to discuss the classes you have already taken. Have your unofficial ACC transcript from WebACCess available! Do this prior to summer or fall registration.
- ✓ Attend the first orientation session that you can. If you are continuing to ACC, New Student Orientation **is** required.
- ✓ **DO NOT** sign up for a course you have already taken. Be sure to pay attention to the course name.
- ✓ If you have kept copies of your syllabus, take those along with you, if the transferability of the course is questioned.
- ✓ Be sure to have your proof of the Bacterial Meningitis Vaccination. You will not be allowed to register for on campus courses without this documentation or a waiver.

Tips & Reminders

- ✓ Dual Enrollment/Credit Academic courses are guaranteed to transfer with a grade C or higher to any Texas Public College/University according to the Core Curriculum transfer rules and regulations. If you have any challenges transferring a course, please let us know immediately.
- ✓ Dual Enrollment/Credit Technical courses are not guaranteed to transfer at the university level but may transfer between community colleges. If you have questions, let us know.
- ✓ All majors are different. How the transferred course is applied to your degree depends on what the degree requires. Some courses may transfer directly into your major, others may only transfer as elective credit.
- ✓ Core completers will receive credit for each course transferred. Students will not be required to pass additional core curriculum courses at the transferee's public institution unless the THECB has approved an expanded core curriculum at the institution.
