New Research Databases in TexShare

A number of new databases are now available in TexShare through the library website. There is no need to change how you search in order to access the information in these databases. It will automatically be added to your searches.

Opposing Viewpoints: Provides pro/con viewpoints for many of today's hottest social issues, from capital punishment to immigration to marijuana. Includes reference articles, interactive maps, infographics, and more.

CREDO: A provider for full text reference information with a collection of over 400 encyclopedia and reference works. These works provide 3.1 million reference entries all connected by millions of links to reference material.

Newspaper Source Plus: Complete text for hundreds of national (U.S.), international and regional newspapers. Also offers television and radio news transcripts from major networks.

MAS Complete: *Attention Dual Credit students!* Full-text database providing hundreds of popular high school magazines and reference books.

Consumer Health Complete: Covers all key areas of health and wellness, from mainstream medicine to the many perspectives of complementary and holistic medicine.

Referencia Latina: Full-text Spanish language database covering a wide number of subjects. It offers content from a variety of sources, including reference books, general interest magazines and health reports.

Business Continuity & Disaster Recovery Reference Center: Has information on business continuity and disaster recovery (BC/DR) that includes risk evaluation, emergency preparedness and crisis communications.

Sustainability Reference Center: Full-text coverage of relevant content in areas of sustainability initiative management.

Chilton Library: Comprehensive, dynamic auto repair support for libraries to provide to their user base.

After that, student ID is all that is required.
