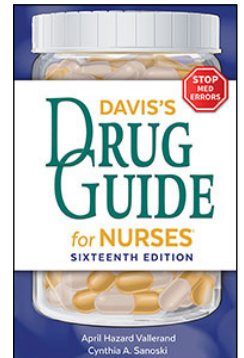

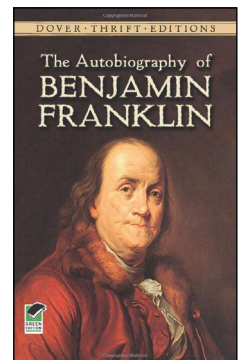

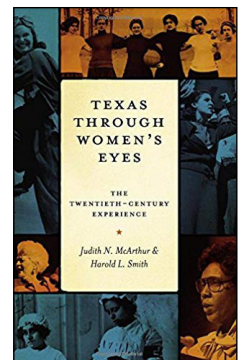

All resources are available during these hours including study rooms and computers.

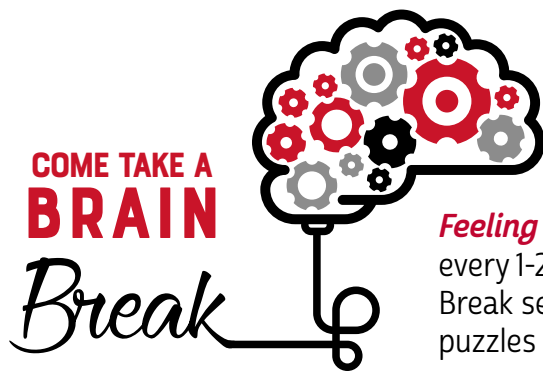
## Library Holiday Hours:
