Degrees:

- Bachelor of Science (B.A.S.) in Theatre with a Concentration in Performance and Directing
- Bachelor of Science (B.A.S.) in Theatre with a Concentration in Musical Theatre

GPA Requirements for Program:

- 2.0 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale.
- All transfer courses require a grade of C or higher.

Requirements to Apply:

- Meet Northwestern State University <u>admission requirements</u>.
- Complete Intent to Transfer form and submit to NSU as directed by a NSU Advisor.
- Complete the Application for Admission into the NSU Theatre/Dance Program.

ACC Credit Hours Required Before Transfer:

- 60 credit hours (B.A.S. in Theatre).
- 60 credit hours (B.A.S. with Concentration in Performance and Directing).
- 60 credit hours (B.A.S. with Concentration in Musical Theatre).

Note - Agreement Information:

Traditional and non-traditional students attending ACC will have the opportunity after completing core requirements at ACC to transfer to an accredited BS in Theatre program that will accept ACC credits.
