

RESPIRATORY CARE ADMISSION POINTS GUIDE

The following point system is used as a guide in the selection of qualified students to be admitted into the Respiratory Care Program. Student selection is based on the total number of points earned below. In the case of a tie, the overall GPA will be considered.

NOTE: If a student was previously accepted into a Health Science Program at Alvin Community College and subsequently deemed ineligible to return to the program, the selection committee has the right to contact the applicant's previous program. This information will be considered for program admission.

PROGRAM COURSE REQUIREMENTS THAT AWARD ADMISSION POINTS

The first three courses are prerequisite courses that must be completed prior to the application deadline.

BIOL 2401	Anatomy & Physiology I	A= 10 pts, B=8 pts, C=6pts
BIOL 2402	Anatomy & Physiology II	A= 10 pts, B=8 pts, C=6pts
ENGL 1301	Composition I	A= 10 pts, B=8 pts, C=6pts
The following courses are required for the degree and will result in more points toward admission if completed with a minimum grade of C prior to the program application deadline.		
CORE 040/050	Select from the Language, Philosophy, & Culture OR Creative Arts Curriculum	A= 3 pts, B=2 pts, C=1pt
BIOL 2420	Microbiology for Non-Science Majors	A= 3 pts, B=2 pts, C=1pts
CORE 080	Select from the Social & Behavioral Sciences Curriculum	A= 3 pts, B=2 pts, C=1pts
