- You must be registered with Selective Service
- You must NOT be in Loan Default
- You must NOT be in Pell overpayment

If you have been affected and will be enrolling for the Fall and would like to apply for this funds, please submit the application at https://alvincollege.academicworks.com/opportunities/609 using the first part of your ACC email address (before the at sign) and your POD password. The application will be available starting *Friday July 31st at 8am* for you to request assistance.

Submission of an application <u>does not</u> guarantee emergency grant funds. If you meet all the qualifications and criteria, the amounts will be determined as follow and will be awarded on a first come first serve basis, until funds have been depleted.

Enrolled in 1 to 8 hours: \$500 Enrolled in 9 to 11 hours: \$600 Enrolled 12 or more hours: \$800

These funds will begin disbursing to the students on September 8th, the amount disbursed will depend on the number of hours registered at the time for each Fall session.

For those approved we will automatically award the funds on the students' award page. If denied, you will be receiving an email communication that will include the reason(s) for denial.
