

## **Dual Enrollment Students with Disabilities**

Students with disabilities seeking to request academic accommodations must identify themselves to Student Accessibility Services (SAS). Students will need to complete a formal request for services (Intake Form) and provide documentation of their disability that meets the specified guidelines. If approved for accommodations it is the student's responsibility to request an accommodation letter for each semester Dual Enrollment coursework is taken. Semester request forms are available on the website.

### **The TSI Test - The Texas Success Initiative Assessment 2.0 (TSIA2)**

The TSI was designed by the State of Texas to reduce the need for accommodations. **THE TEST HAS NO TIME LIMIT**, so students can take as long as needed to complete each section. Students can also start and stop as necessary (except when given a writing prompt). Additionally, there is a calculator built into the math section and there are accessibility features available that offer enlarged font and background color change for visual assistance (these will need to be set up at the start of the test). Students are able to take the test at ACC or online.

### **Academic Accommodations in College**

Accommodations (not special education) are provided on a case-by-case, as-needed basis in order for students with disabilities to have equal access to the institution's programs and activities. Academic Accommodations in College are not curriculum modifications. For example, extra time on testing is an approvable accommodation, but extra time to complete assignments, or reduced coursework is a curriculum modification. Most accommodations approved for Dual Enrollment coursework taken at the high school will be implemented by the instructor or appropriate high school staff.
