

EBSCO Databases Help Sheet

1. Go to www.alvincollege.edu/library.aspx or [on the POD under Campus Services/Library](#)
2. Click on [The EBSCO databases via Texshare](#)
3. **If this is your first time accessing the databases from off campus, you will need to select Alvin Community College from the drop down menu and then add the password.**
4. **If prompted select ACC as your library and if prompted enter ID **RCC5268** and password **TX77511****
