ACC Student Ambassadors represent the college both on and off campus. The organization is looking for students from diverse backgrounds who demonstrate excellent communication skills and leadership potential. Student Ambassadors provide information about ACC's programs and assist with recruitment activities. A \$600 scholarship is awarded each semester.

### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

- Enrolled in at least nine (9) hours at Alvin Community College during the Spring 2022 semester
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher AND be in good Academic Standing
- Availability for some evening and/or weekend events
- Reliable transportation for off-campus events
- Excellent communication and leadership skills, outgoing personality and exhibits ACC pride TO BE CONSIDERED AN APPLICANT, ONE MUST:
- Complete and submit an application to Recruiting (Room A115) no later than **February 28, 2022.**
- Submit a 30 second video explaining why you chose to attend Alvin Community College
  OR submit an essay explaining why you are the right choice for the Ambassador program no later than
  February 28, 2022. We understand ACC is local and affordable, so think outside the box. You will be judged on creativity, originality and quality of information given.
- Submit one (1) letter of recommendation (family members/significant others may not be included)
- Submit a current college or high school transcript unofficial transcripts are accepted
- Participate in an interview with selection committee members

### **DUTIES:**

- Assist College Recruiter with community and campus events
- Disseminate information regarding ACC programs and services to the community
- Give campus tours to prospective students (individual and group)
- Assist with campus events
- Special assignments

### COMMITMENTS:

- Minimum of 60 hours of service per semester
- Maintain a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA
- Attend required training sessions and monthly meetings
- Be reliable for scheduled time commitments
- Display a positive and cooperative attitude at all events and meetings

### **REWARDS:**

Through the planning and production of these activities, Student Ambassadors will have the opportunity to develop a wide range of professional skills, such as team leadership and event management. In addition, Ambassadors will be eligible for:

- \$600 scholarship
- Opportunities to be "the face of ACC" on marketing materials
- ACC promotional items
- Networking opportunities with ACC faculty and administrators
- A Certificate of Service
