

Alvin Community College Medication Aide to Vocational Nursing Bridge Program

Eligibility Requirements

- Meet all requirements for the Traditional VN Program
- Have current Med Aide certification from Texas Health & Human Services
- Have current Nurse Aide certification from Texas Health & Human Services
- Minimum of 6 months experience at a long-term care facility

Traditional VN Program Requirements

- Be admitted to Alvin Community College
- Provide proof of prior education (GED, Diploma, or College Credits)
- Satisfy Texas Success Initiative (TSI) requirements
- HESI A2 exam scores minimum of 70 in the Reading Comprehension section and 65 Cumulative score
- Hepatitis B vaccinations or immunity titer

Medication Aide to VN Bridge Program Structure

- Classes begin each Summer semester
- First semester is 2 courses instead of 5 courses in the traditional VN program
- First semester theory courses are online; lab skills and check-offs are in-person at the ACC West location
- Students attend with traditional VN program students for the second and third semester courses held at the ACC Alvin location (in-person attendance required for all courses second and third semesters)
- May substitute BIOL 2401 & 2402 for VNSG 1420 Allied Health Anatomy & Physiology in the first semester (see restrictions in the VN instruction packet)

Course Fees and Expenses

- First semester
 - CEVNSG 1071: \$1,300
 - VNSG 1420 Allied Health A&P In-district: \$465; Out-of-district: \$669
- Second semester courses: In-district \$1,920; Out-of-district \$2,685
- Third semester In-district \$2,550; Out-of-district \$3,400
- Additional expenses \$1,115 (see VN instruction packet for details)

Application Process

Apply to Alvin Community College (select the next available semester). The Apply Texas website is https://www.applytexas.org or scan



Submit a second application to the Nursing Dept. in October. The VN website is https://www.alvincollege.edu/vocational-nursing/application.html or scan



- Look for your "successful submission" email to acknowledge receipt of your nursing application
- Submit Hepatitis B vaccination or immunity records with application
- Attend an applicant meeting during the application period. Meetings are listed in the application instructions and on the nursing webpage.
- Check your milestones to verify all requirements were completed before the application deadline
- Applicants are notified of their status by the end of January
